Mitzvah Match Board Game Instructions (609)



Object: Be the first to travel around the game board by matching the mitzvahs.

Contents: I game board, 25 picture cards, 4 different colored pawns

Setting up the Game:

Gently remove the 25 picture cards out of the cardboard sheet and discard the extra cardboard. Be careful not to ruin any of the cards.

Each player chooses one of the pawns. Each player should place his pawn in one of the corners of the game board. This is his starting spot.

Place the cards face down on the colored squares in the middle of the game board.

How to Play:

Youngest player goes first. Play proceeds to the left.

In order to advance, you must find the mitzvah card that matches the picture on the game space where your pawn is standing.

Remember to always move clockwise along the game path.

On your turn, flip over one of the cards in the middle.

Turn it over so that everyone can see it.

Look and see if it is a match, a miss, or a picture of the name of the game.

MATCH: If the card matches the picture where your pawn is, move to the next square and remember to turn that card facedown again. Every time you make a match, take another turn.



A MISS: If the card you turned over does not match the picture where your pawn is, turn the card back over and you can not move your playing piece. Your turn is over.



MITZVAH MATCH CARD:

If the card that you turned over has the bright red Mitzvah Match logo on it, you're a lucky mitzvah mentch (person). Move your pawn one space ahead and take another turn, the same as you'd do if you made a match. Once you flip over the Mitzvah Match logo card, take the card out of the game.

To Win the Game:

Be the first player to move your pawn all the way around the game board and back to your original starting place.

Shorter Version:

Instead of playing all the way around the game board, the first player to go from his starting place to the next starting place on the corner wins.

Important Note for Players:

By using his/her memory, a player may advance to his next space by matching a card to his game space that he is on. A player is encouraged to pay attention to the cards that opponents turn over — perhaps they will turn over a card that he is looking for.

Playing by Yourself:

This is an excellent game to help develop your concentration and memory skills. Play from one corner to the next corner or play around the whole board. See how many turns it takes you to complete the game!
